Eligible Partnerships

- 1. Can there be more than 3 institutions in a proposal, if the requirement of minimum of one U.S. institution and one SENAI institution is met?
 - Yes, there is no limit to the number of institutions that can participate in your partnership as long as you meet the minimum requirement of one US institution and one SENAI institution.
- 2. Is it possible to participate in a partnership between 3 institutions (one from Brazil, one from the U.S., and one from Canada)
 - No, Canadian institutions are not eligible to participate in this competition at this time. Only Brazil and U.S. institutions may apply.
- 3. Would it be allowed to bring companies to partner together with SENAI institutes and U.S. HEIs in the development of projects?
 - Yes, other non-HEI partners, including government, NGOs, businesses, and other community partners are able to participate in and support the project. They may not apply for a grant.
