Q: HOW MANY INSTITUTIONS CAN BE INVOLVED IN MY PROPOSED PROJECT? A: THERE IS <u>NO LIMIT</u> TO THE NUMBER OF INSTITUTIONS THAT CAN BE INVOLVED IN THE PROJECT.

Q: WHICH INSTITUTION HAS TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION? A: THE PRIMARY APPLICANT HEI CAN BE FROM <u>EITHER</u> THE U.S. OR COLOMBIA.

Q: CAN WE INCLUDE A PARTNER INSTITUTION THAT IS NOT IN THE U.S. OR COLOMBIA?

A: FOR THIS INNOVATION FUND COMPETITION, ONLY INSTITUTIONS IN THE U.S. AND COLOMBIA ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY AND BE BENEFICIARIES.

Q: HOW MANY PROPOSALS CAN MY INSTITUTION SUBMIT? A: THERE IS <u>NO LIMIT</u> TO THE NUMBER OF PROPOSALS THAT AN INSTITUTION CAN SUBMIT, HOWEVER, IT IS UNLIKELY THAT A SINGLE INSTITUTION WILL RECEIVE MORE THAN ONE GRANT AWARD IN A SINGLE GRANT COMPETITION.

Proposals must propose, or be connected to, a research project focused on the cacao sector and describe how the project will enhance the capacity of students and faculty to perform advanced, applied agricultural research.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS & CONSIDERATIONS







In-person student mobility is <u>required</u> in at least one direction

IN-PERSON STUDENT NOBILITY

Bi-directional preferred, but not required.

No minimum/maximum number of students

No minimum/maximum duration of stay

*Given the ongoing challenges & uncertainties due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we understand/encourage proposals that allow for <u>both physical and virtual exchange</u>.



Students can be at any level of <u>post-</u> <u>secondary education</u>.

Student Credit

<u>Students must</u> <u>receive some level of</u> <u>academic credit</u> from their home institution during or as a result of the proposed program.



Diverse Students

Special consideration will be given to proposals focused on programs that benefit <u>underserved</u>, non-traditional, <u>and/or diverse student</u> <u>populations</u>.
