over \$20 million from public / private sectors to support the Innovation Fund since 2013

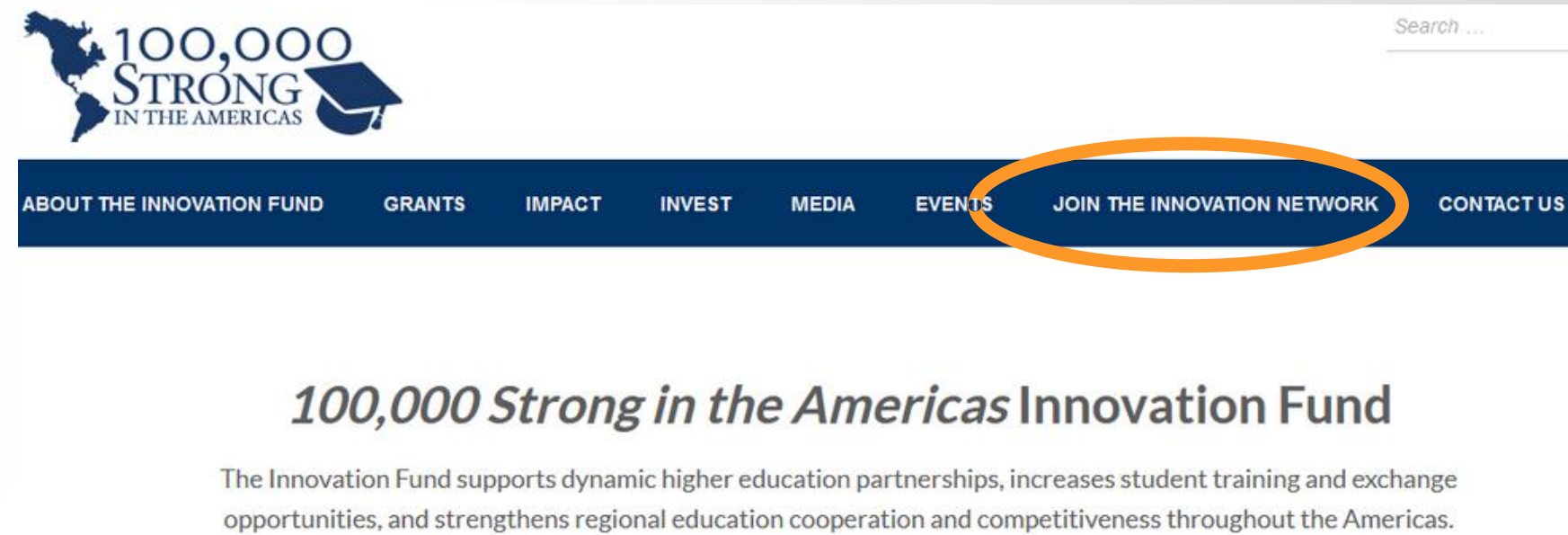

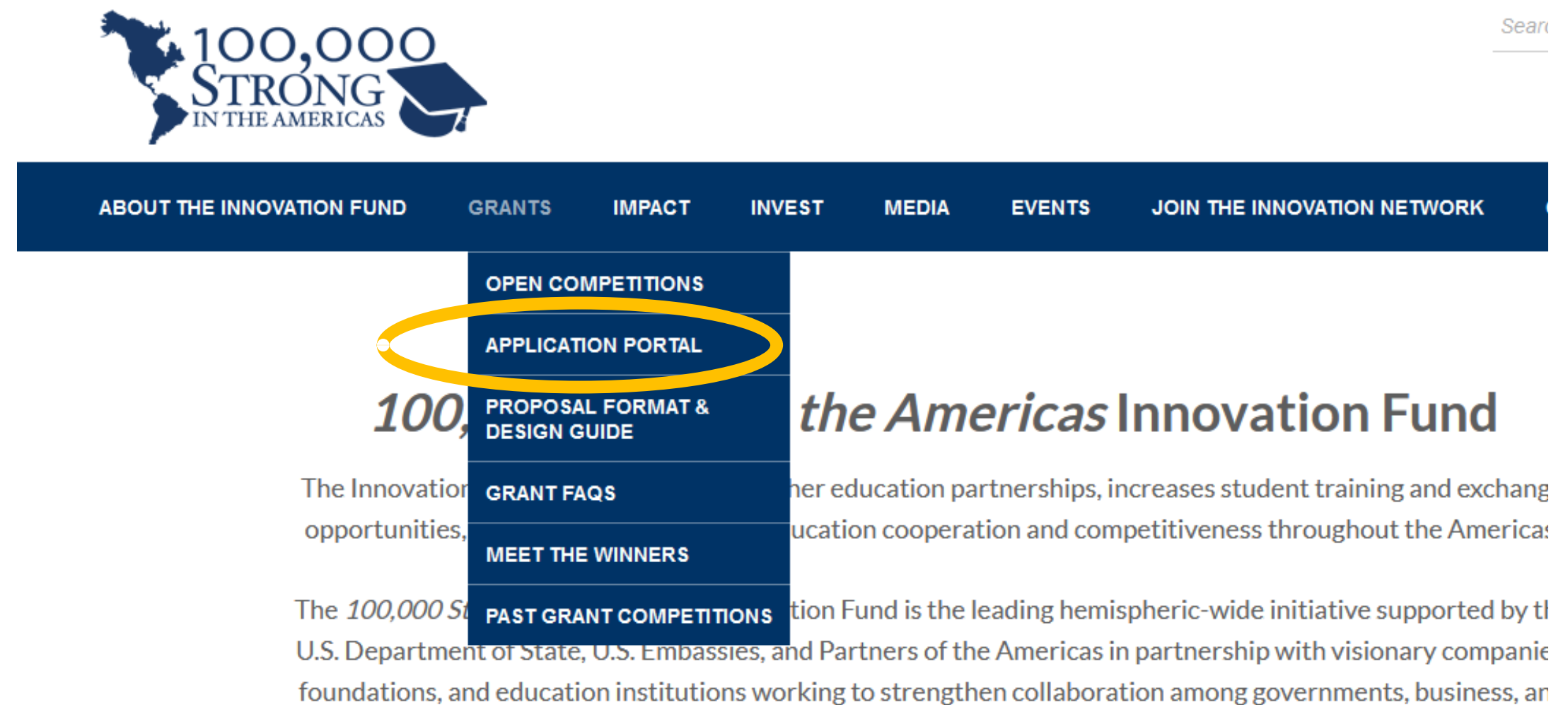

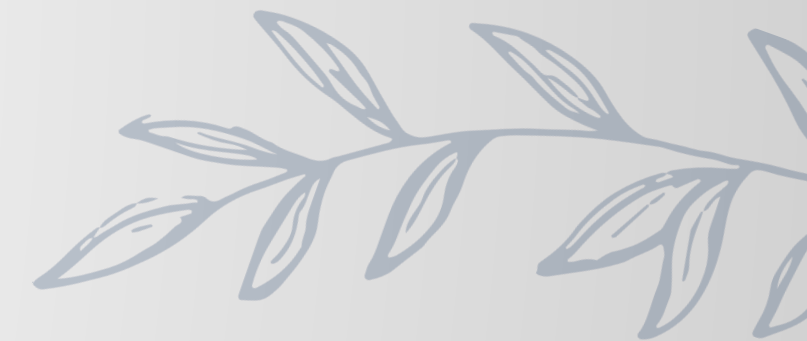

◆ Climate Action Project

HEIs must use grant resources to start, sustain, or expand a strategic, ambitious Climate Action Project (CAP) that leverages the unique capacity and skills of the HEI community.

CAPs must fall within one or more Action Categories:

- **Research**
- **Anchor Institution**
- **Education**
- **Advocacy**
- **Administration/finance**
- **Operations**

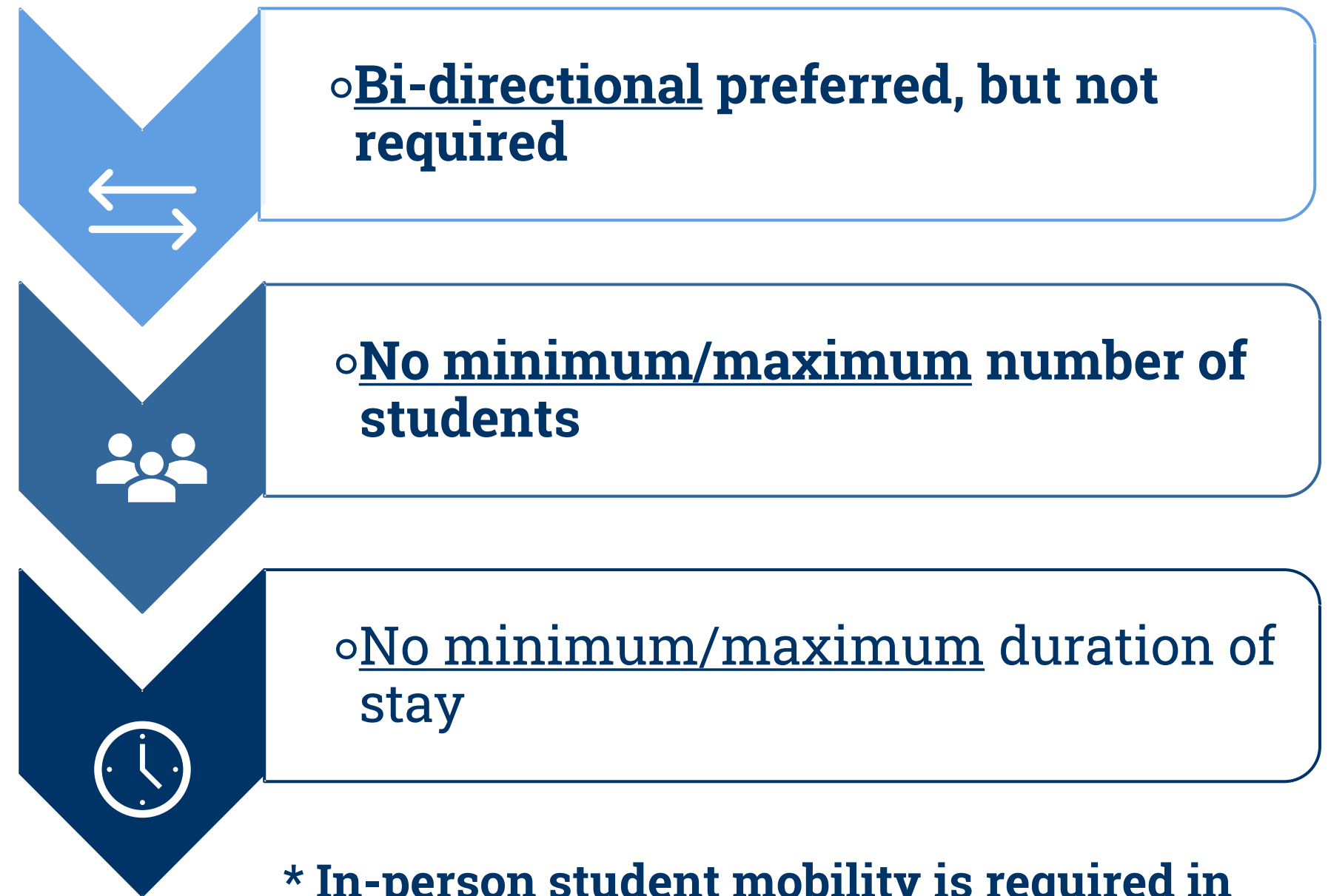

In-person Student mobility

Program Design



Level of Study

Students can be at any level of post-secondary education

Undergraduate

Student Credit

Required: Students must receive some level of credit from their home institution during or as a result of the proposed program.



Diverse Students

Special consideration will be given to proposals focused on programs that benefit underserved, non-traditional, and/or diverse student populations.
