

Background









The 100K Innovation Fund is the public-private sector partnership and collaboration among the Bureau of Western Hemisphere Affairs at the U.S. Department of State (WHA/DOS), U.S. Embassies, and Partners of the Americas, working with companies, foundations, regional government entities, and academic networks throughout the United States, Latin America, and the Caribbean.

The goals of the 100K Innovation Fund align with DOS priorities to build institutional capacity, increase access to inclusive education opportunities, stimulate economic prosperity, and contribute to workforce development.

Over \$20 million from public / private sectors to support the Innovation Fund since 2013







Step 1: Online Application Portal






Step 2: Create a Profile






Step 3: Use an appropriate email

Announcing new 100,000 Strong in the Americas grant competition to expand trilateral higher education cooperation and inclusive, climate-action focused student/faculty exchanges between the United States, Canada, and Mexico.

Note: See Request for Proposals (RFP) for requirements and themes.

Application Period:

November 16, 2023 - February 29, 2024











Eligible Countries



Bi-lateral partnership required

Project Design Aspects

Teams of HEIs should use 100K grant funds to:

- 1. Create and implement innovative, inclusive student and/or faculty training and exchange programs between the U.S., Canada, and/or Mexico.
- 2. Bilateral or trilateral focused climate action projects (CAPs), that contribute to climate-action solutions.

EligibleInstitutions

Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) located and legally registered in the United States and Colombia

Proposals that include one or more Minority Serving Institution (MSI) in the United States will be found favorable during the evaluation process.

- Historically Black College & University (HBCU),
- Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI),
- Tribal College & University (TCU), and/or
- Community College

*While your institution may submit any number of proposals, the 100K team will not be selecting more than 2 winning proposals per institution for each 100K competition



Project Design

Nine (9) grants of up to \$25,000 available to proposals that include both climate research connected to a climate action project (CAPs) and student/faculty exchange and training programs.

- •Bioeconomy and Sustainable Value Chains
- •Climate Justice
- Conservation and Reforestation
- •Endangered/Threatened Species Management and Protection
- Environmental Protection
- •Green/Climate Finance

- •Renewable Energy

- •STEM for Climate Purposes
- •Sustainable Design, Architecture, and Construction
- •Sustainable/Electric Transportation

Level of Study

Students can be at any level of post-secondary education

Undergraduate Graduate Doctoral



Student Credit

Required: Students must receive some level of credit from their home institution during or as a result of the proposed program.



Diverse Students

Special consideration will be given to proposals focused on programs that benefit underserved, non-traditional, and/or diverse student populations.

*Include student Diversity Recruitment Plan







In-person Student mobility



•<u>Bi-directional</u> preferred, but not required



 No minimum/maximum number of students



No minimum/maximum duration of stay

* In-person student mobility is <u>required</u> in at least one direction

Frequently Asked Questions



Q: How many institutions can be involved in my proposed project?

A: There is <u>no limit</u> to the number of institutions that can be involved in the project.

Q: Which institution has to submit the application?

A: The primary applicant HEI can be from any of the eligible countries.

Q: Can we include a partner HEI that is not in the U.S., Canada, or Mexico?

A: For this Innovation Fund competition, <u>only</u> institutions in the listed countries are eligible to apply and be beneficiaries.

Q: How many proposals can my institution submit?

A: There is <u>no limit</u> to the number of proposals that an institution can submit, however, a single institution will not receive more than two grant awards in a single grant competition.


